Garage Project Tiny XPA

<0.5% ABV, 330ml RRP \$4 and 6-pack RRP \$19

This XPA is the second release under Garage Project's Tiny no-alcohol brand and packs just as much flavour as its predecessor, Tiny Hazy IPA. An extra pale ale, Tiny XPA is a pale golden, super crisp ale brewed with pilsner malt, Simcoe, Strata and Citra hops for juicy hop characters and tropical aromatics.

Sawmill Non-Alc Bare Beer Hazy IPA

<0.5% ABV, 330ml 6-pack RRP \$20.99

The no-alcohol beer category continues to blossom and Sawmill have followed up the success of their initial Bare Beer pale ale with a Hazy take on the same. A juicy IPA with big tropical and citrus aromas, the haze rounds out the brew and obscures the absence of alcohol even more. With less than half a percent ABV, this is a beer that is good to go anywhere, anytime.

Mikkeller Drink'in The Sun

0.3% ABV, 330ml RRP \$5.50

Belgian brewery Mikkeller has taken the zero alcohol and run with it all the way to a Belgian wheat beer style. This is a pale golden drop with notes of banana and coriander seed.

Mikkeller Weird Weather

The brainchild of Danish science teacher and brewing pioneer Mikkel Borg Bjergsø, Mikkeller Weird Weather Non Alcoholic IPA is a floral, New England Style IPA with a full body and grassy notes of pine. Brewed in Belgium, this is a light non-alcoholic drop with a subtle haze throughout. Serve extra cold.

Export Ultra Low Carb Lager

4.2% ABV, 330ml, 745ml and keg – from RRP \$19.99 for 330ml 12-pack.

Export is now offering an Ultra Low Carb version in its popular lager range. This new addition to the line-up is 99% carb-free, 99% sugar-free and contains only 26 calories per 100 ml. DB says it is "made for Kiwi beer drinkers who appreciate low bitterness, [and] refreshing lagers."

The new Tiny XPA is the second release under Garage Project's Tiny no-alcohol brand.

McLeod's Sunset Surf Pale Ale

4.5% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

US Loral and New Zealand Nectar hops combine for a wave of flavour in this new release from McLeod's. Floral pineapple and soft citrus notes drift over a smooth malty base with just enough bitterness to keep it refreshing and crisp.

McLeod's Billycan Milk Stout

This rich stout pours black as night with a creamy off-white head, and boasts Tahitian vanilla and cacao nibs in the mix. Roast malt aromas and a luxurious palate of coffee and cocoa laced with vanilla, rum and soft liquorice notes. Full-bodied and rich with balanced bitterness for a soft, toasty finish.

McLeod's Blue Sky American Pale Ale

5.3% ABV, 440ml RRP \$8.99

This American-style Pale Ale uses Talus and Citra hops for plenty of bright grapefruit over citrus aroma and flavour. It's all balanced on a soft malt base with golden oats for a slightly moreish note and balanced bitterness.



Sprig + Fern Duhoppily Fresh Hop Hazy

5.5% ABV, 440ml RRP \$8.99, 888ml RRP \$13.99 – also in keg

With the local Nelson hop farms just minutes away, Sprig + Fern's brewers jumped in the van and returned with two hop varieties from two farms: Pacifica from New Hoplands and the sought-after Riwaka hop from Holmdale Farm. This hazy pale ale combines orange zest marmalade with pungent tropical, grapefruit and citrus notes – like fruit salad in a glass.

Sprig + Fern Harvest Pilsner™

5.5% ABV, 440ml RRP \$7.99, 888ml RRP \$12.99 – also in keg

Sprig + Fern's multi-award-winning Harvest Pilsner™ marries Riwaka and Motueka hop varieties, harvested by its brewers on their annual pilgrimage to the local hop farms in the Nelson region. This Pilsner is fresh and juicy, oozing tropical and citrus notes and the zest of lime.

Sprig + Fern Superdelic Fresh Hop Pale Ale

5.5% ABV, 440ml RRP \$8.99 – also in keg

The Sprig + Fern brewers were thrilled to use the new Superdelic hop from NZ Hops for this fresh hop brew. They've let its full flavour shine, getting it straight from bine to brew. Superdelic packs juicy berry and tropical fruit flavours and aromas, as well as tangy citrus and sweet, candy-like characteristics.

Garage Project Liquid Refreshment NZ IPA

5.6% ABV, 330ml RRP \$4.50

The team at Garage Project describe this as beer as “100% Kiwi hopped” as it's brewed with a selection of Aotearoa's finest and finished with a hit of brand new liquid Motueka SubZero Hop Kief. This is a bright golden IPA with clean, snappy bitterness and luscious lifted notes of citrus, feijoa and ripe stone fruit.

Sawmill Chocolate Stout

5.6% ABV, 500ml RRP \$12.99

Sawmill's Chocolate Stout is one of their seasonal brews and this year they've used cacao nibs and cocoa husks from Lucid Chocolatier in the Wairarapa. The cacao and cocoa in the brew create a smooth chocolate hit, while oats give this dark drop a luscious, velvety texture.

Emporium Hippogate Saison

6% ABV, 330ml RRP \$6 – also in keg

A classic Saison from Kaikōura brewery Emporium. There's subtle spice on a graham cracker base and hints of stewed citrus fruit on the mid-palate. A delicious autumnal offering.

Emporium Wet Exit Fresh Hop Cold IPA

6% ABV, 330ml RRP \$6 – also in keg

The team at Emporium used fresh Motueka hops picked from Okuora Farm in Canterbury and quickly slung them into this Cold IPA for a really nice resinous bite. Hints of watermelon with a citrus mid-palate makes for an intriguing combination.

Hop Federation Green Limousine Fresh Hopped IPA

6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99 – also in keg

Hop Federation's signature fresh hop beer returns for 2023 – Green Limousine is an IPA fresh-hopped with Nelson Sauvignon hops grown just down the road from the brewery. It's so close, in fact, that they're off the bine and into the brew in as little as 30 minutes. It also uses Nelson Sauvignon, Taiheke and Southern Cross hops that are picked, dried, pelletised and into the whirlpool within 24 hours. The result is a golden brew full of luscious fresh hop character.

McLeod's Jump Rock Unfiltered IPA

6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

This IPA is named for a favourite local jumping off point with the crew at Northland brewery McLeod's. One of McLeod's signature unfiltered IPA bases is loaded with Nelson Sauvignon and Simcoe hops. It's all gooseberry, citrus and fresh pine needle, alongside a hint of toffee and soft malts. Balanced and fresh.

Pacific Coast Brewery x Hop Revolution Tapawera NZ Pils

6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$10 – also in keg

Nelson's Hop Revolution have teamed up with new Mangawhai brewery Pacific Coast to craft this crisp and delicious New Zealand Pilsner. Gladfield pale pilsner malts were paired with Riwaka hops, LalBrew NovaLager yeast and then dry-hopped with Nelson Sauvignon for balance. The result is a flavourful pils with gooseberry and pine notes that keep you coming back for more.

Sawmill Azacca Hazy IPA

6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

This bright orange hazy from Matakana's Sawmill uses the Azacca hop, named after the Haitian God of Agriculture. Combined with Mosaic hops, the brew features tropical and citrus notes, softened and balanced by the embracing haze. A dry finish keeps you going back for more.

Sawmill Fresh Hop Riwaka Hazy IPA

6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$11.99

This golden hazy is a joy to behold after a long day. The orange, green, and purple graphic style on the can is eye-catching and in the glass there are big punchy grapefruit and passionfruit aromas from the freshly harvested Riwaka hops, which hit the brew within 24 hours of picking on the hop farm in Tasman.

Sawmill Fresh Hop Superdelic Hazy IPA

6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$11.99

Brewed with all-New Zealand ingredients, this big, bold IPA is a feast for the senses. Sporting a beautiful soft pink can, this hazy is full of freshly harvested Superdelic hops – the newest hop variety from NZ Hops. Think tropical, ripe mango and sweet berries, all bound with a soft mistiness.

Bach Brewing Duskrider Red IPA

6.2% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

A re-release, last seen in 2021, Bach Brewing's Duskrider Red IPA is a combination of hoppy goodness with a caramel toffee malt. Pouring a dark ruby colour in the glass, the hop varieties – US Cascade, Amarillo, Citra and Nelson Sauvignon – give flavours of pine and citrus while the malts add sweet caramel notes. Complex yet balanced.

Bach Brewing Sticky Buds Nelson Sauvignon Fresh Hop IPA

6.2% ABV, 440ml RRP \$10.99

The “sticky buds” in this brew are green Nelson Sauvignon hops, picked fresh and delivered to Bach Brewing in Auckland for a major fresh hop punch. The brewers describe the aromas as “pungent and skunky” while the juicy flavours are a heady blend of tropical, citrus and gooseberry.

Sawmill Fresh Hop Superdelic Hazy IPA uses the latest hop release – Superdelic – from NZ Hops. Think tropical, ripe mango and sweet berries, all bound with a soft mistiness.





Epic Hop Gator
6.3% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

Epic's new fresh hop release uses super fresh Motueka hops grown on Eggers Hop Farm in Nelson. The hops were picked, packed, flown to Auckland and added to the tank within six hours to create a hazy IPA that's packed full of juicy Motueka crushed lime character.

Badass Beverages California Sun
6.4% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

Named after the classic R&B track, California Sun brings together the best from both West and East Coast styles of IPA. Smooth, fruity and aromatic, there's also a hint of smokiness at the end – like a day spent in the California sunshine and finished off with a beach bonfire at night.

Bach Brewing Flock of Seagulls
6.5% ABV, 440ml RRP \$10.99

This is Bach Brewing's tribute to its top-of-the-South-Island roots and as such this Tasman Bay Hazy IPA is brewed with all-Nelson hops: Riwaka, Nectar, Nelson Sauvín and Kohatu. So hazy you'd probably describe it as milky, there are flavours of stone and tropical fruits, all nicely rounded out by the soft Nelson haze.

McLeod's Mt Lion IPA
6.5% ABV, 440ml RRP \$10.99

Mt Lion IPA takes its name from an iconic local range at Bream Head, not far from McLeod's Waipu brewery. Idaho 7 and Citra hops bring dank orange and citrus character with fruit-laden aromas and taste. It's all balanced on a light malt base with a hint of caramel and smooth bitterness for a super drinkable IPA.

Bach Brewing Velvet Marley Chocolate Cherry Stout
6.6% ABV, 440ml RRP \$9.99

This dark brew is a veritable dessert in a glass. It's easy to be seduced by its dark berry, creamy vanilla and cacao nib characters. There are powerful cherry and raspberry layers that lead to a slightly funky, smoky mid-palate and sherbet-like finish. Impeccably balanced.

McLeod's Subtropical Stout
6.7% ABV, 440ml RRP \$8.99
McLeod's Brewery

This is McLeod's take on a classic tropical stout, made in New Zealand's winterless north. Well-crafted and warm-fermented, the brewing style is suited to balmy islands and equatorial climes. Roasted malts up front with rich, fruity espresso and chocolate notes. Drinks like a slightly-sweetened espresso with a smooth, medium body hinting at alcohol for a touch of winter warmth.

McLeod's Forty Acre Fresh Hop UIPA
6.8% ABV, 440ml RRP \$10.99

First brewed in 2016, Forty Acre is a celebration of the New Zealand hop harvest. The McLeod's team uses fresh green hop cones harvested in Nelson, flown directly to their Waipu brewery and used within hours of picking. They use over 400 kilograms in one batch for big, green resin-like hop character over a sublime oily texture with a mouthful of flavour.
